Training: Parenting Coordination

Course Description. A two-day training to give dispute resolution professionals the knowledge and skills necessary to serve as parenting coordinators. This training will describe the interventions helpful in reducing parental conflict, focusing on understanding the psychological dynamics of the parents and the impact of the conflict on the children. The parenting coordination process, structure and roles will be described, emphasizing the practical aspects of serving as a parenting coordinator. The use of parenting coordination in cases with allegations of domestic violence, alienation and child abuse will be discussed as well as the types of cases that are not appropriate for parenting coordination. This training will also discuss the ethical issues inherent in this role and present an overview of standards of practice.

Recommended pre-requisites:

In order to gain the most from this training you should have the following courses before attending: 1) Basic Mediation (minimum of 12 hours), 2) Domestic Abuse Issues (14 hours) provided by the Supreme Court of Ohio, and 3) Specialized Family/ Divorce Mediation (minimum of 40 hours).
